Production aircraft now incorporate a new battery holder for alternator field priming batteries. The new installation will accommodate four 1.5 volt "C" size cells which are used to energize the alternator field in the event that power from the aircraft battery is not available to do so.

The battery holder used in earlier aircraft (serials shown above) was designed to accommodate four 1.5 volt "1/2 D" size cells. Since the battery manufacturer has discontinued making the "1/2 D" size cells, a Service Kit has been developed to update these earlier inservice aircraft with this new battery holder.

Service Kit SK337-46A is now available from the Cessna Dealer Organization and should be incorporated on affected aircraft serials at the next alternator field priming battery change interval.
